CALL TO ORDER	The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Bob Haueter, Chairman.
NEW BUSINESS	Consider Bids for Roadwork: Woody Baker reported that he escorted five contractors around the roads on the Flying L, but only one company sent in their bid. He has contacted seven more contractors in San Antonio to get more bids for the roadwork and he plans to be very specific about the work that needs to be done. Roads will need to be extended to the new homes on Tawny Oak, Deerwood and Brown Saddle Circle. The deadline for submission of bids will be November 7, 2019. The bids will be reviewed and awarded at the November 12, 2019 board meeting.
	The board discussed the benefit of asphalt over chip sealed roads. Asphalt roads will last about 20-25 years, while chip seal should last about 10 years. Although asphalt costs twice as much, it will last twice as long, so the cost is comparable. After discussing the pros and cons of asphalt over chip seal, a motion was made by Glen McComb and seconded by Diane Segura to pave all the roads with asphalt. The motion carried unanimously.
